SUBJECT: Reaction to Student Situation

REF : Rio 9144; SãO Paulo 1920; Brasilia 2927

1. Although many major figures absent from Brasilia over weekend, soundings of congressmen and officials of executive branch indicate that government reacting calmly thus far to current student demonstrations. At present there no suggestion that drastic measures being contemplated by federal authorities. General opinion is that if demonstrations remain at ~~approx~~ present level they will continue be dealt with by police. Troops will be used only if situation gets out of hand.

2. In conversation with EmbOffs there was noticeable reaction from congressmen of both parties against what they felt to be police brutality in Rio June 20/21 and

overreaction in Brasilia June 22. Pictures of student-police clashes in Rio appearing in today's press were widely cited as proof that Guanabara police action was excessive. This opinion shared even by normally pro-government figures such as Chamber of Deputies president Jose Bonifacio.

3. On more speculative plane, some sources noted world-wide nature of students protests and said they viewed current Brazilian events as merely one more manifestation of this phenomenon.
