

THE OFFICERS WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE MEETING WITH HIM AS MODERATES WHO SINCERELY HOPED THE U.S. GOVERNMENT WOULD NOT IMPOSE PENALTIES ON BRAZIL, BECAUSE THE CURRENT MOOD OF THE BRAZILIAN OFFICER CORPS COULD GENERATE IRREVERSIBLE NEGATIVE REACTIONS WHICH COULD SEVERELY DAMAGE LONG-TERM BRAZILIAN-US RELATIONS.
